



NOTICE OF VIRTUAL MEETING

PLANNING & ACCESS COMMITTEE Monday 30th August 2021 – 2.00pm

In light of the current guidance on COVID-19/Coronavirus we are taking steps to allow us to continue to deliver our services during this time with as little disruption as possible.

However to help protect staff and customers from risk and prevent the potential spread of the virus, our offices are currently closed to the public and staff are working from home until further notice where possible.

As a result the Monday 30th August 2021 Planning & Access Committee meeting, which would normally be held in public, will now take place as a virtual meeting. This virtual meeting will be webcast live for public viewing.

In advance of the meeting, the committee has agreed to conduct a site visit in relation to application 2020/0260/DET. In line with the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020 and to minimise the environmental impact to a Special Area of Conservation, this visit – which would normally be accessible to the public – will be attended only by relevant staff, members of the Planning and Access Committee and the applicant and/or their agent.

A webcast link for the live virtual meeting will be posted thirty minutes before the meeting start time. The live virtual meeting will begin at 2.00pm and at this time you will be able to view the meeting, although not participate, as is normal unless you are participating as a speaker as outlined in our Standing Orders.
